## *Sparkling & Champagne*

- Burn Valley Classic Brut NV, North Creake, Norfolk, United Kingdom** £48  
Locally grown and produced, subtle on the palate with hints of strawberry and brioche.
- Gocce di Favola, Prosecco Extra Dry NV, Veneto, Italy** £24  
A fresh, fragrant and fruit Prosecco with aromas of pear and apple. On the palate it is off-dry and lively with an attractively crisp finish.
- Paco & Lola Vineyards, Lola Cava Brut NV, Rias Baixas, Spain** £32  
Notes of apple, citrus, marzipan and white flowers, the palate is fresh and creamy bubbled. Soft on the attack, fruity and balanced.
- Cloudy Bay Pelorus, Marlborough, New Zealand** £35  
Light, clean, fine citrusy, apple crispness.
- Camel Valley Brut, Cornwall, United Kingdom** £42  
Fresh yeasty aromas, English hedgerow scents with good acidity and a touch of honey on the palate.
- Chapel Down Brut Rose, Tenderen, United Kingdom** £36  
Locally grown and produced, subtle on the palate with hints of strawberry and brioche.
- Veuve Clicquot Brut NV Yellow Label, Reims, Champagne, France** £70  
This champagne manages to reconcile two opposing factors - strength and silkiness - and to hold them in perfect balance with aromatic intensity and a lot of freshness. This consistent power to please makes it ideal as an aperitif, and perfect as to enjoy with a meal.
- Taittinger Prestige Brut Rosé NV, Reims, Champagne, France** £80  
Stylish and dry with delicious summer fruit aromas and a long, full-bodied flavour typical of Pinot Noir based Champagnes.
- Bollinger Special Cuvee Brut NV, Ay, Champagne, France** £85  
A subtle combination of structure, length and vivacity ; bubbles like velvet ; pear, brioche and spicy aromas, notes of fresh walnut.
- Louis Roederer Vintage Rose 2014, Reims, Champagne, France** £95  
A ripe, complex and youthful bouquet of slightly tangy red fruit, ripe citrus and roasted cocoa beans. After some time in the glass, the wine reveals sappier, floral and sweet notes with a saline, almost briny, core.
- Laurent Perrier Cuvee Rose NV, Tours-sur-Marne, Champagne, France** £105  
Elegant, with colour changing naturally from a pretty raspberry hue to salmon pink. A precise nose of extraordinary freshness and a wide range of red fruits: raspberry, redcurrant, strawberry and black cherry.
- Louis Roederer Cristal 2013, Reims, Champagne, France** £298  
Powerful and complex on the palate, revealing a mixture of yellow fruit, juicy, ripe fruits, citrus peel and finely-roasted nuts. The nose is simultaneously powdery and sweet, with elegant, chalky notes.
- Ruinart Blanc de Blanc, Reims, Champagne, France** £105  
Powerful and complex on the palate, revealing a mixture of yellow fruit, juicy, ripe fruits, citrus peel and finely-roasted nuts. The nose is simultaneously powdery and sweet, with elegant, chalky notes.

# White Wine

**Burn Valley Vineyard, Solaris, North Creake, Norfolk, United Kingdom** **£38**

Gloriously buttery and vanilla alongside a touch of well-integrated oak. Well balanced with a long lingering finish.

**Novita Pinot Grigio, Venetie, Italy** **£21**

A vibrant tangy freshness with aromas of pear, grapefruit zest and a hint of spiciness are the hallmarks of good Pinot Grigio and we're delighted that this wine exhibits those qualities. The quaffing drink par excellence.

**Stonier Chardonnay, Mornington Peninsula, Victoria, Australia** **£45**

Fresh and aromatic, this easy-drinking Chenin Blanc shows gentle aromas of tangy green apples and is beautifully balanced with a crisp acidity and a deliciously fruity finish.

**Paco & Lola 'Lolo Tree', Albariño, Rías Baixas, Spain** **£25**

This estate grown and bottled Albariño shows stone fruit characters with delicate spicy notes on the nose, which are echoed on the palate along with citrus characters. This poised wine is all held together by a crisp backbone of refreshing and zesty acidity.

**Hazy View Chenin Blanc, Western Cape, South Africa** **£20**

Fresh and aromatic, this easy-drinking Chenin Blanc shows gentle aromas of tangy green apples and is beautifully balanced with a crisp acidity and a deliciously fruity finish.

**J. Moreau et Fils, Gloire de Chablis, France** **£40**

Fresh, bright aromas of citrus fruit and floral notes are elegantly enveloped in subtle, smoky mineral notes. Crisp on the palate, with refreshing, vibrant white fruits complemented by a hint of butter, good structure through to a dry, mouthwatering finish.

**Petit Ronde Picpoul de Pinet, France** **£20**

Fresh, citrusy with a stone fruit character. Floral notes, aromas of peach and is beautifully balanced with a crisp acidity and a delicious dry finish.

**Chateauneuf-du-Pape Blanc, Clos de L'Oratoire des Papes, Ogier, France** **£67**

Fresh and aromatic, this easy-drinking Chenin Blanc blend shows gentle aromas of tangy green apples and is beautifully balanced with a crisp acidity and a deliciously fruity finish.

**Feudi di San Gregorio, 'Pietracalda', Campania, Fiano di Avellino, Italy** **£48**

Aromas of exotic fruits are enhanced by spicy undertones. Notes of fresh flowers, such as chamomile, freshly picked stoned fruits and candied citron are balanced by a crisp palate, with a lovely creamy texture and distinct minerality on the finish.

**Pascal Clement Macon Village, Burgundy, France** **£25**

Floral and fruit aromas such as acacia and honeysuckle, lemongrass, and citrus mingle on a refreshing palate

**Roman's Bay Sauvignon Blanc, Western Cape, South Africa** **£25**

Aromas of exotic fruits are enhanced by spicy undertones. Notes of fresh flowers, such as chamomile, freshly picked stoned fruits and candied citron are balanced by a crisp palate, with a lovely creamy texture and distinct minerality on the finish.

**Joseph Mellot 'La Grande Chatelaine', Sancerre, Loire Valley, France** **£55**

A fresh and lively Sancerre, offering pure aromas of citrus fruit and white pear with delicate elderflower nuances. Crisp and elegant, with beautiful mineral tension on the palate through to a zesty, mouth-watering finish.

**Vine Trail Gewurtztraminer, Rapel Valley, Chile** **£25**

A crisp, aromatic wine, showing great purity and a precise expression of this variety. Fresh notes of orange blossom, lychee and rose

**Vavasour Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand** **£32**

A bright, clean, crisp wine, freshly cut grass, gooseberries & grapefruit.

**Virgen de Galir Maruxa Godello, Valdeorres, Spain** **£38**

Mature white fruit and mineral notes with a fresh balanced palate.

**Emile Beyer Riesling, Organic Riesling Traditional, Alsace, France** **£33**

Lemon & grapefruit fruit aromas, backed with plenty of fresh fruit on the finish.

**Louis Jadot Chassagne Montrachet, Cote d'Or, Burgundy** **£75**

Beautifully balanced Chardonnay, minerality, balanced oak.

**Quinta das Arcas Arca Nova Branco, Vinho Verde, Portugal** **£20**

Green apple and sweet pear with a touch of spritz on the finish.

## *Rose Wine*

**Estandon 'Heritage', Côtes de Provence, France** **£25**

Pale salmon in colour, this is the quintessential Provence rosé. A refreshingly fruity bouquet leads to delicate white spice and mineral flavours on the palate and an elegant finish.

**Wicked Lady, White Zinfandel, California, USA** **£21**

Shows red-fruits on the rich, juicy palate. A fruit-forward-yet-bold red that's loved for its red fruit flavors and smoky exotic spice notes.

**Château de Campuget 'Le Campuget' Vin de Pays du Gard, France** **£23**

A delicate pale pink, with a fresh wild strawberries and hints of grapefruit on the nose. Refreshing with a persistent finish, completed by subtle hints of nectarine. Simply delicious.

## *Red Wines*

**Burn Valley Vineyard, Marsh Red, North Creake, Norfolk, United Kingdom** **£34**

A very easy drinking wine made from Pinot Noir & Rondo. The fruits of plum and raspberry and cherry are integrated with subtle oak, soft tannins and balanced acidity.

**San Silvestro 'Patres', Barolo, Piedmont, Italy** **£55**

A crisp, aromatic wine, showing great purity and a precise expression of the Verdejo variety. Fresh notes of pear, grass, fennel and white pepper lead to a dry and refreshing palate, with excellent balance and a citrus finish.

**Bodegas Ondarre, 'Rivallana' Crianza, Rioja, Spain** **£23**

Spicy, ripe fruit aromas are complemented by subtle hints of vanilla oak. On the palate, savoury characters are layered with ripe fruit flavours in this traditionally styled Rioja.

<b>Chateau Cissac, Haut-Medoc, Bordeaux, France</b>	<b>£39</b>
Black cherry, cassis and hints of spice. Distinctive depth of colour and a subtle balance between aromas of cherry and plums, mingled with liquorice and smoke.	
<b>Between Thorns Shiraz, South Eastern Australia</b>	<b>£20</b>
Cherry, raspberry and spice.	
<b>Louis Jadot, Volnay, Burgundy, France</b>	<b>£75</b>
The Volnay wines combine distinction, nobility, finesse and femininity. They offer an incomparable bouquet of red berries, violets and vanilla.	
<b>Berton Vineyard 'Winemakers Reserve', Padthaway, 'The Black' Shiraz</b>	<b>£28</b>
The wine is an extreme example of this Australian Shiraz with deep colour and aromas of blackberry and plum over toasty coffee and spicy oak. The palate is full flavoured and intense with rich plum, blueberry and mocha notes. The tannins are ripe and dense imparting great structure and length to the palate.	
<b>Olifantsberg Pinotage, Breedekloof, South Africa</b>	<b>£39</b>
Bright notes of cherry, wild strawberry fruit and ripe raspberry are interlaced by hints of spice and earthy notes. This wine is made in a pure fruit-driven style, with supple tannins and reveals a fresh and elegant expression of Pinotage.	
<b>Finca Bacara, Time Waits For No One 'White Skulls', Jumilla, Spain</b>	<b>£31</b>
A juicy, punchy and opulent red with attractive floral aromas, ripe fruit and balsamic notes in the background. Balanced freshness on the palate lifts the vibrant fruit through to a smooth and persistent finish	
<b>Chateau Musar Red, Bekaa Valley, Lebanon</b>	<b>£65</b>
Sumptuous, rich dark fruit and spice aromas followed by intense flavours of plum, cherry and dark chocolate. Finishing with a balanced palate and a touch of oak.	
<b>Salentein Barrel Selection Malbec, Uco Valley, Argentina</b>	<b>£28</b>
Blackberry, blueberry and redcurrent, with subtle hints of violet.	
<b>Terre du Soleil Merlot, Pays d'Oc, Languedoc-Roussillon, France</b>	<b>£22</b>
Bursting with blackberry & blueberry, with a touch of spicy oak, represents the terroir well.	
<b>Joseph Mellot Destinea Pinot Noir, Val de Loire, France</b>	<b>£24</b>
Refreshingly light with a soft palate, rounded with red fruit.	
<b>Le Coq Perdu Malbec, Pays d'Oc, France</b>	<b>£22</b>
Bursting with blackberry & blueberry, with a touch of spicy oak, represents the terroir well.	
<b>Vidal Reserve Pinot Noir, Marlborough, New Zealand</b>	<b>£28</b>
A crisp, aromatic wine, showing great purity and a precise expression of the Verdejo variety. Fresh notes of pear, grass, fennel and white pepper lead to a dry and refreshing palate, with excellent balance and a citrus finish.	
<b>Kleine Zalze Cabernet Sauvignon 'Vineyard Selection', Stellenbosch, S. Africa</b>	<b>£26</b>
Rich blackcurrant, soft tannins, well balanced oak, hints of vanilla.	
<b>Feudi Salentini 125 Primitivo del Salento, Italy</b>	<b>£23</b>
Elegant with notes of ripe plum, cherry jam and cocoa.	

<b>Chalk Hill Luna Shiraz, McLaren Vale, Australia</b>	<b>£24</b>
Dark raspberry and blackcurrant, with floral aromas and a hint of chocolate.	
<b>Chateauneuf-du-Pape, Les Bartavelles, Jean-Luc Colombo, France</b>	<b>£70</b>
Powerful, full, complete and silky with notes of ripe fruit and liquorice.	
<b>Jean Loren 'Domain des Dames de la Roche', Brouilly, Beaujolais, France</b>	<b>£27</b>
Vibrant summer-fruit bouquet with a typically light ripe, juicy palate.

<b>Leftfield Albarino, Gisbourne, New Zealand</b>	<b>£36</b>
Citrus flowers, melon and peach, the palate shows some richness, backed by stone fruit & lime.	
<b>Edouard Delaunay 'Septembre' Pinot Noir, Bourgogne, France</b>	<b>£29</b>
Raspberry, blackcurrent and cherry, nice balance with oak.	
<b>Between Thorns Cabernet Sauvignon, South Eastern Australia</b>	<b>£20</b>
Blackcurrent with hints chocolate and vanilla.	
<b>Dona Paula 'Paula' Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina</b>	<b>£21</b>
Intense purplish red colour. Sweet, spicy and intense aromas, with notes of red fruits and herbs, this wine is soft, velvety, fresh, and well balanced.
